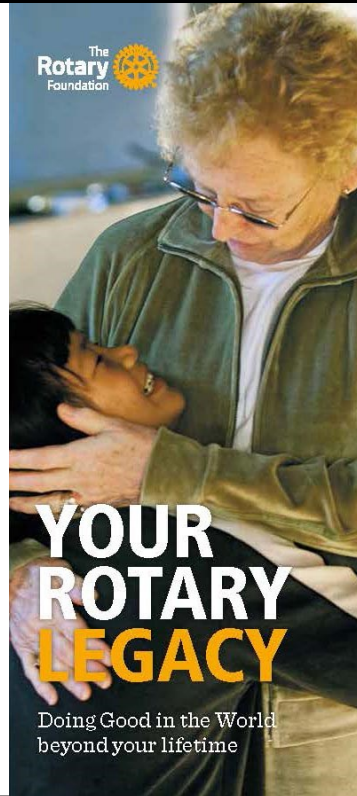

## A POLIO MILESTONE: THE SWITCH

Going Away: Oral Vaccine



NEW: Injectable Vaccine



Last year there was a 75% reduction in polio cases, and more countries were infected by vaccine-derived polioviruses than wild polio.

To reduce these risks, in April there will be a globally synchronized switch from the oral vaccine to inactivated polio vaccine that will take two weeks in 155 countries. It will be the biggest coordinated effort of its kind and will be a major milestone towards achieving the eradication of all polioviruses worldwide.
